CMP Procedure Updates & Reminders

Dropping off and Picking up Your Child

When you drop your child off each day you are required by state law to sign-in and note your sign-in time. Before you leave, please make sure that you check-in with the teacher so she is aware that your child has arrived.

When you pick up your child, you are required by state law to sign-out and note the sign-out time. Please be sure to check-in with the teacher so that she is aware that your child is departing.

When coming and going from the CMP parking lot, we encourage you to hold your child's hand and proceed cautiously.

Give your child the gift of your full attention when you pick them up from school. *Please leave your cell phone in the car and ask them about their day. It is the greatest gift you can give.*

General Tuition Information

Weekly tuition is due on Monday in advance for the week, and will be considered late if not paid by Friday. Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month in advance, and will be considered late after the 5th. A late charge of \$20.00 per week will be applied to your account until the balance is paid in full.
